

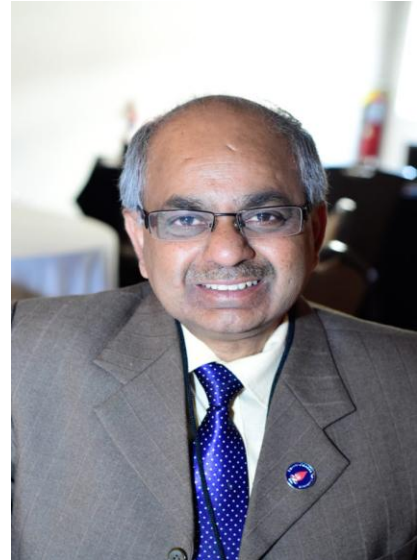
“LITTLE THINGS WE DO”
